Game Protocol for Oakwood Field Hockey at Lane Stadium

Gates will open

4:30 - 5:45 p.m. for Varsity spectators, 6:15 - 7:15 p.m. for JV spectators

When your party arrives

- Each participant is permitted to have 2 people attend the game (JV or Varsity) in which he or she is playing.
- Spectators should stay in their car until their entire party is present and the gate is open.
- Masks are mandatory for all spectators from the time a person leaves his or her car until returning to it.
- Parties for all spectators will line up 6 feet apart at the entrance to the Lane Stadium.
- There will be hand sanitizer at the gate. All spectators will "gel in" using provided hand sanitizer upon entering the stadium.

Entrance to Lane Stadium

- Masks are required. Anyone without a mask will not be admitted.
- Self-assessment health checks should be done prior to arriving at the stadium.
- Any person who does not feel well or had "close contact" with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days should not travel to the event.

- When a party of spectators goes to the bleachers, home spectators should sit on a yellow dot marker, visiting spectators should sit on a blue dot marker.
- Parties for each participant will sit together as a pod at a dot marker.
- Spectators will not move the dot markers.
- No congregating is permitted before, during or after the game.

During the field hockey game

- Bathroom facilities are available.
- No concessions or water fountains will be available.
- Spectators are welcome to bring water, coffee, tea or soda pop.
- Spectators are expected to sit in marked seats only. Family and household members should sit together, socially distanced from others.
- Masks must be worn in the bleachers AT ALL TIMES.
- No re-entry for any reason.
- Many games will be live streamed or posted on the OakwoodSchools YouTube channel.

Dismissal Procedure

 At the conclusion of each game, all spectators will leave immediately, go to their cars and leave the area, allowing time for school staff to sanitize.

- Parents may pick up participants outside the stadium in their cars.
- There will be no loitering in the parking lot at the beginning or end of the game.
