Players, Coaches, Athletic Trainers:

- Check-In: All players, coaches, and athletic trainers should 1. follow our COVID check in process. Visiting team will complete symptom checks before leaving their home site. Locker Rooms will **not** be available, and **players are** expected to bring their own water.

Spectators:
