

Classrooms

- When students are out of the classroom, daytime service staff will use spray bottles, with alcohol/water mixture, to clean hard surfaces, including desktops, chairs, sink area (faucet, sink, hand soap dispenser) and countertops.
- When students are present in the classroom, teachers will use alcohol/water mixture (spray or wipes) to wipe down desks and chairs as needed throughout the day.
- Nighttime service staff will use chemical disinfect and combination of three different devices (Clorox 360 Electrostatic Sprayer, Protexus Electrostatic Wand and Karcher Mister/Pressure washer) to clean all hard surfaces in classrooms.

Restrooms

- Following every period transition at OJH/OHS, all restrooms (toilet seats, flush handles, stall door, lock area) will be disinfected and checked for paper products/soap. All soiled areas will be disinfected.
- On an hourly basis at the elementary schools, all restrooms (toilet seats, flush handles, stall door, lock area) will be disinfected and checked for paper products/soap and all soiled areas will be disinfected.

Common Areas

- Following students entering the building, entry doors and all high touch areas including water bottle fillers, stair wells and handrails will be disinfected. On a bi-hourly basis, all high touch areas including water bottle fillers, stairwells and handrails will be disinfected.

Playground Equipment

In half-day mode:

- Following each use, the playground equipment will be sprayed with 70% alcohol/water mixture.
- Prior to the start of each school day, playground equipment will be wiped down with chemical disinfectant using microfiber cloth.
