

Oakwood Schools Foundation Facilitates Matching Gift for Alumni Plaza



In anticipation of the upcoming 50th OHS reunion this fall of the Class of 1967, an OHS alum wanted to learn about the needs of OHS. In reviewing those needs, it was the proposal of an “Alumni Plaza” to be installed in one of the most highly visible and traveled areas on the OHS/OJHS campus that intrigued the private donor. Hundreds of students walking to campus use daily the area directly to the east of the entrance to Oakwood Junior High, between the school building and Schantz Avenue. The Schantz Avenue entrance is the most-used entrance to the complex not only by students, faculty, and staff but also by visitors, parents and sporting event attendees. This high-traffic area can create a messy environment in adverse weather, and the ground surrounding the walkways is quickly trampled.

The proposed plan (see illustrated concept) would transform this outdoor space into a durable location serving many purposes including: a venue for Oakwood students and community members, an outdoor classroom for instruction, a small gathering area for band/orchestra performances, and an area for pre-game events. Funding of this project would complement the upgrades done in 2004 and 2015 to make this one of the most attractive and useful locations at Oakwood Schools. District officials anticipate the cost, when completed, would be approximately \$100,000.

The private alumni donor established a fund, providing \$50,000 as a matching gift challenge, in hopes of making the Alumni Plaza a reality. Please consider the value of an Oakwood education in your life or the lives of your children and grandchildren. Coaches Groom Next Generations of Lumberjack Athletes

Have you ever been in the crowd at an OHS event and done a double-take at who was coaching? With the great numbers of dedicated alumni who have chosen to stay involved in the schools and raise their own families in the area, it may not be surprising, but it sure is awesome. Of almost 90 coaches and volunteers supporting the student athletes at Oakwood Junior and Senior High, almost a quarter are former students themselves. We caught up with a few of them to learn how they got their start.



John Lefforge ('99) and Carson Deck ('99)

– 8th Grade Football

How did you get involved with coaching?

John: My father ran the Oakwood Youth Football/Basketball Programs. He got me started right out of high school, and I have been coaching ever since.

Carson: Being a teacher and competitive person, coaching felt like a natural progression of classroom teaching. I was asked to coach Junior High basketball at my former school and did for 8 years. Through conversations with John Lefforge about those coaching experiences, I joined the Oakwood Junior High football coaching staff.

How long have you been coaching?

John: This will be my 8th year as the head coach for Oakwood 8th Football.

Head Oakwood 8th Boys Basketball: 2010 – 2013.

Head Oakwood 7th Boys Basketball: 2013 – present.

Carson: This is my 7th year of coaching 8th grade football.

What do you enjoy the most?

John: The relationships you establish with the players and staff. Getting to be out there every day with a great group of individuals is very rewarding.

Carson: I enjoy the players and coaching staff. They're all great guys, and watching the players move on to the Friday night lights is very rewarding.

What is your favorite coaching memory?

John: Winning the 2012 8th Boys Basketball Tournament at Oakwood. That Oakwood 8th Boys Basketball team was awesome! It was a privilege to be their coach.

Carson: My favorite memory is always changing. One memory that stands out right now was the game against Bellbrook 4 years ago, which was the team composed of this year's Seniors. Our team executed flawlessly and could do no wrong. We beat a very tough team with ease that night.



Kyle Duwel ('94) – Men's Varsity Soccer

How did you get involved with coaching?

About 15 years ago, I saw an article in the paper that Oakwood was looking for a new soccer coach. By the time I expressed interest, the position had been filled, but I was asked if I would like to become the Junior Varsity coach. I accepted.

How long have you been coaching?

This is my 15th year with the Oakwood soccer program and the second as Varsity Coach.

What do you enjoy the most?

The teaching part. It is fun to share my soccer experiences with the high school students.

What is your favorite coaching memory?

Ring the bell to acknowledge Oakwood winning/sharing the SWBL title.

What else should we know about you?

I am a proud "Domer" and continue to live in Oakwood with my wife, Jen and our three kids, Kacy, Claire, and Jonathan ... and that the 1992-93 Oakwood High School basketball team belongs in the Hall of Fame! Go Jacks!






